Six (6) Single-sided Retractable Banners & Stands, typical for all

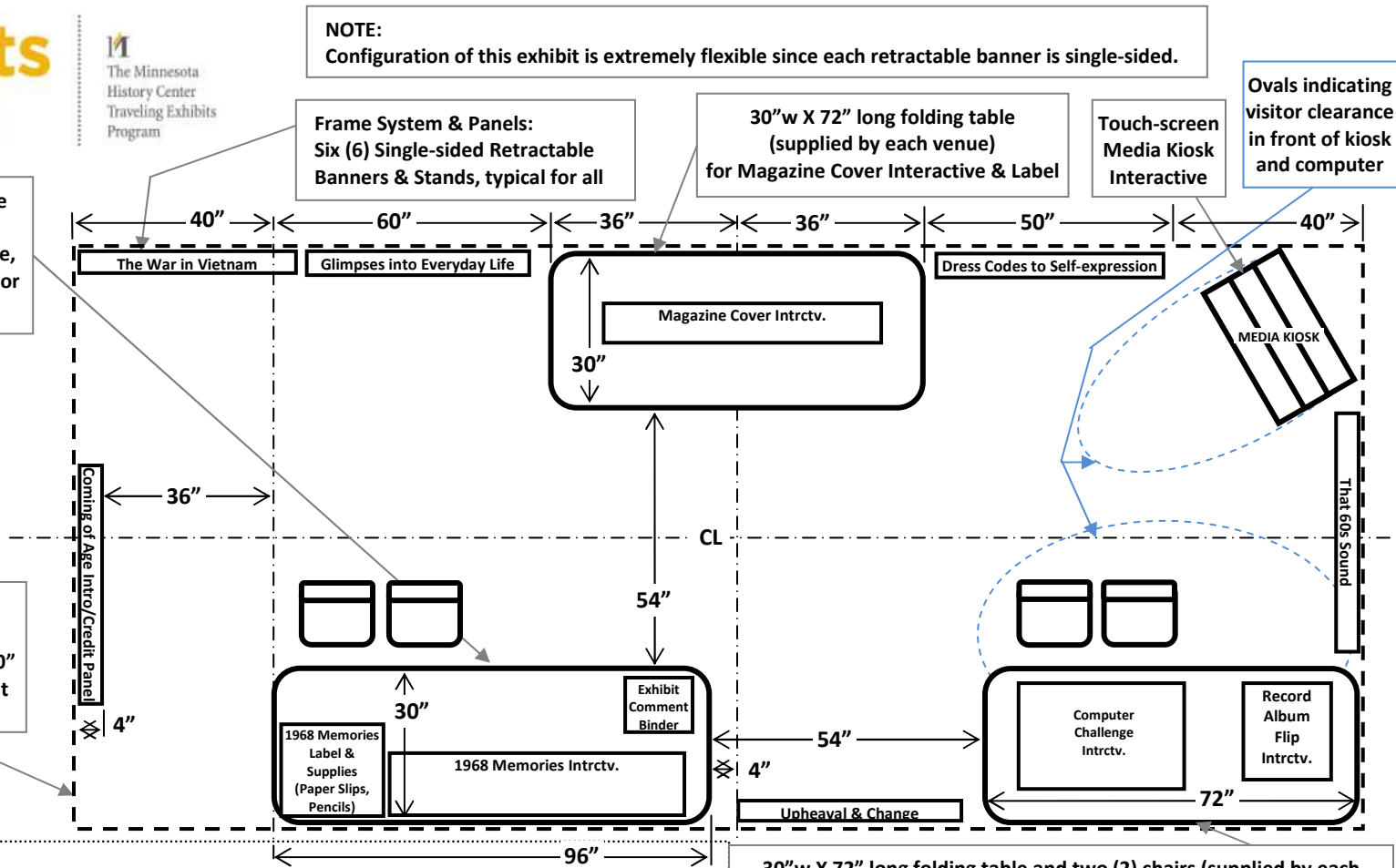
30" w X 72" long folding table (supplied by each venue) for Magazine Cover Interactive & Label

Ovals indicating visitor clearance in front of kiosk and computer

30" w X 96" long folding table (supplied by each venue) for 1968 Memories Interactive, Label & Supplies, and for Visitor Comment Binder

**Minimum Space Rectangle:**  
(+/-) 22'-0" X 10'-0"  
**NOTE:** This DOES NOT allow 3'-0" of walk space at the ends and at the sides
