ACCUSED by the Grand Jury of the County of St. Louis, Minnesota, by
this indictment of the crime of Murder in the First Degree,

to-wit:
Committed as follows: The said William Rozon,
on the fifteenth day of
June, A. D. 1920, at the City of Duluth,
in the County of St. Louis and State of Minnesota, with a premeditated

design to effect the death of one Isaac McGhie, a human
being, did wrongfully, unlawfully, wilfully and feloniously
kill the said Isaac McGhie by then and there strangling
the said Isaac McGhie with a rope, which said killing of
him, the said Isaac McGhie, by him, the said William Rozon,
was then and there without excuse, justification or author-
ity of law, contrary

Contrary to the form of the Statute in such case made and provided,
and against the peace and dignity of the State of Minnesota.
